- e) Exodus 29:21 says, “...and he shall be _____, and his _____, and his sons, and his sons’ garments with him.” (hallowed; garments)
- f) What type of offering is mentioned in Exodus 29:24? (Wave offering)
- g) Exodus 29:38 reads, “Now this is that which thou shalt offer upon the _____; two _____ of the _____ year day by day continually.” (altar; lambs; first)
- h) According to Exodus 29:45, God says, “And I will dwell among the children of _____, and will be there _____.” (Israel; God)

1) Exodus 30 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What piece of tabernacle furniture is mentioned in Exodus 30:1? (Altar of Incense)
- b) How often was Aaron to burn incense upon it? (morning and evening, vs. 7-8)
- c) According to this chapter, those who were _____ years of age and above were to give an offering or contribution to the Lord. (Twenty, vs. 14)
- d) What was this contribution or collection to be used for? (For the service of the tabernacle which involved sacrifices related to atonement for their souls, vs. 16)
- e) What item is discussed beginning in Exodus 30:18? (The Laver)
- f) Did the priests have to “wash with water, that they die not” before they entered the tabernacle? (Yes, vs. 20)
- g) Were the tabernacle and its furniture to be anointed? (Yes, vs. 26ff)
- h) Exodus 30:29 reads, “And thou shalt _____ them, that they may be most _____: whatsoever toucheth them shall be _____.” (sanctify; holy; holy)
- i) In the section of Exodus 30:29-38, how many times is the term “holy” found? (Eight times)

2) Matthew 27 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What was the name of the governor that Jesus was delivered to? (Pontius Pilate, vs. 2)
- b) What did Judas end up of doing to himself? (Committing suicide by hanging himself, vs. 5)
- c) When Jesus was accused (falsely accused) by the chief priests and elders, how did Jesus answer? (He answered nothing, vs. 12)
- d) What “notable prisoner” did the people choose to have released instead of the innocent Jesus? (Barabbas, vs. 16ff)
- e) List some of the terrible things that were done to the Savior Jesus Christ during His unjust trial and murder? (See, vs. 26ff; Although Judas, the wife of Pilate, Pilate himself, etc. knew of His innocence, and proclaimed such, Jesus was to be crucified, while the wicked Barabbas was to be released. Jesus was “scourged” in a horrible manner and then turned over to ruthless soldiers who “mocked Him” and then “spit upon Him, and took the reed, and smote Him on the head. And after that they mocked Him, they took the robe off from Him, and put His own raiment on Him, and led Him away to crucify Him.” Jesus was so weak from the horrific abuse that He was too weak to carry His own cross to Golgotha. They gambled over His clothing. Additionally, “they that passed by reviled Him, wagging their heads.” This is but a very brief description, and all of the crucifixion chapters should be studied together to understand the full import of what happened to the sinless Jesus. Truly the words of 2 Corinthians 8:9 could serve as a commentary, “For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that ye through His poverty might be rich.”)
- f) When Jesus died on the cross, what happened to the veil in the temple? (It was rent or torn in two from the top to the bottom, vs. 51)
- g) What is the name of the rich man who buried Jesus in his tomb? (Joseph of Arimathaea, vs. 57)

4. Wednesday –

1) Exodus 31 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What are the names of the two chief men mentioned in the building of this furniture? (Bezaleel and Aholiab, vs. 2, 6)
- b) Per Exodus 31:6 and Exodus 31:11, did God consider “strict obedience” important? (Yes!!)
- c) Were the children of Israel to “keep the Sabbaths?” How many were they to keep? How often did the Sabbath come around? (Yes; All of them; Once a week, vs. 14ff)
- d) Upon what mountain did God tell Moses all these things? (Mount Sinai, vs. 18)
- e) The two tables of testimony were made out of what substance? (Stone, vs. 18)

2) Matthew 27 – Read & Word Study/Research

- a) Did Judas know that Jesus was innocent? What about Pilate’s wife? What about Pilate himself? (Yes, all three realized this, vs. 4, 19, 24)
- b) What is the name of the person that was compelled by the Roman soldiers to carry the cross of Jesus? (Simon of Cyrene, vs. 32)
- c) The place called “a place of a skull” was also know as _____. (Golgotha, vs. 33)

- d) What Old Testament passage prophesies about what is fulfilled in Matthew 27:35? (Psalm 22:18)
- e) How long was darkness over the earth? (For three hours, from noon until 3 p.m., vs. 45)
- f) When Jesus died, what happened with certain righteous people who had previously died? (As the text says, “many bodies of the saints which slept arose, and came out of the graves after His resurrection...”, vs. 52-53)
- g) Was the tomb of Jesus guarded by Roman soldiers thus preventing the stealing of His body? (Yes, vs. 62-66)

- c) Exodus 32:6 says, “...and the people sat down to eat and to _____, and rose up to _____.” (drink; play)
- d) What did God say that the people had done to themselves, per Exodus 32:7? (He said that they had, “corrupted themselves.”)
- e) Based on the plea of Moses, to God, to spare the people, did Moses understand “the promises” originally given to Abraham? (Yes, vs. 13)

- d) Matthew 28:8 says, “And they departed quickly from the sepulcher with _____ and great _____; and did run to bring his _____ word.” (fear; joy; disciples)
- e) The first people to “see” the resurrected Christ were men or women? (Women, vs. 9-10)
- f) What did the Jewish leaders offer the soldiers to fabricate a story about how Jesus was stolen away as they slept? (Large money, vs. 12-15)

- a) Were the tables of stone going to be like or unlike the tables of stone that Moses had broken? (The would be like the first ones, vs. 1)
- b) Exodus 34:6 says, “And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, _____, and abundant in _____ and _____.” (longsuffering; goodness; truth)
- c) When Moses saw the glory of the Lord as He passed by, what did Moses immediately do? (He immediately bowed his head to the ground and worshipped, vs. 8)
- d) Did God warn them not to make a covenant with the people of Canaan? (Yes, vs. 12ff)
- e) How many times a year were the men to appear before the Lord God as such pertained to the keeping of certain feasts? (Three times in the year, vs. 23)
- f) How many days was Moses on the mount? (40 days and 40 nights, vs. 28)
- g) What happened to the face of Moses? (The face of Moses “shone,” or was illuminated and he had to put a veil on his face when speaking with the people, vs. 29-35)
- h) Did Moses tell all the people of God’s commandments? (Yes, vs. 32)
