

# THE BIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

## **WEEK 87 – Psalm 39 – 44 & Ephesians 5 – 6**

**Overview** – This study is a 6 day program covering both the Old Testament (OT) and the New Testament (NT). This study program is to take place on a daily basis (Monday through Saturday). The study will involve reading/studying 6 OT chapters and 2 NT chapters per week. The OT chapters will only be covered 1 time with the NT chapters being covered 3 times. Depending on reading speed, chapter length, etc., total study time should take approximately 15 to 30 minutes a day. In other words, by simply dedicating only about 15 to 30 minutes a day (6 days a week) to Bible study, in roughly 2 ½ to 3 years, you will have read and studied the entire Bible. If followed, you will have read the OT once and the NT three times, while studying through the entire Bible. The KJV (King James Version) is used to prepare the questions.

**How it works** – Read, study, and/or answer questions as outlined below. Place an “x” in the blank after you have completed each day’s study. If you are unable to do the study on the set day, either try to “double up” and get back on schedule or if you get several days behind, simply skip to the current day’s schedule. If necessary you can always come back weeks or months later and study the chapters you missed. You will be able to identify any missed chapters easily if you consistently mark your studied chapters with an “x.” Practically speaking, however, this is not advisable and the student is encouraged to “stay on the daily schedule.” In short, this program will not work, if you do not commit yourself to a daily study habit. We also suggest that the student keeps the weekly study program sheets in a 3 ring binder for easy reference. It is likewise necessary that everyone in the local congregation who is involved in this study program get together weekly or at least biweekly to review the questions and answers.

2. **Monday** –

1) Psalm 39 – Read & Answer Below

- a) This psalm opens with the psalmist saying, “I said, I will take heed to my \_\_\_\_\_, that I sin not with my \_\_\_\_\_....”
- b) The phrase, “My heart was hot within me, while I was musing the fire burned...” is found in what verse?
- c) Psalm 39:4 reads, “Lord, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my \_\_\_\_\_, what it is; that I may know how \_\_\_\_\_ I am.”
- d) Speaking to God, in what verse does the penman say, “...mine age is as nothing before Thee?”
- e) Again speaking of God, in what verse does David say, “...my hope is in Thee?”
- f) Psalm 39:12 begins, “Hear my \_\_\_\_\_, O Lord....”
- g) The phrase, “...before I go hence, and be no more” reflects the psalmist’s words in what verse?

1) Psalm 40 – Read & Answer Below

- a) Psalm 40:1 begins, “I waited \_\_\_\_\_ for the Lord....”
- b) As this psalm begins, the psalmist declares that God has put at new \_\_\_\_\_ in my mouth, even praise unto our God....”
- c) The statement, “Blessed is the man that maketh the Lord his trust...” is found in what passage?
- d) Psalm 40:5 reminds us, “Many, O Lord my God, are Thy \_\_\_\_\_ which Thou hast done, and Thy thoughts which are to us-ward: they cannot be \_\_\_\_\_ up in order unto Thee: if I would declare and speak of them, they are \_\_\_\_\_ than can be numbered.”

2) Ephesians 5 – Read & Answer Below

6. **Friday** –

1) Psalm 43 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What are the first four words of this psalm?
- b) The end of Psalm 43:1 reads, “...O deliver me from the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ man.”
- c) Speaking to God, in Psalm 43:3, the psalmist says “O send out Thy \_\_\_\_\_ and Thy \_\_\_\_\_....”
- d) In this psalm, does the psalmist refer to God as his “exceeding joy?”
- e) The phrase, “...hope in God...” is found in what verse?

2) Ephesians 6 – Read & Answer Below

- a) What verse says, “Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right?”
- b) What verse in this chapter commands “fathers” to take the lead in raising their children “in the nurture and admonition of the Lord?”
- c) What verse in this chapter begins the discussion regarding “servants?”
- d) What verse in this chapter begins the discussion regarding “masters?”
- e) Ephesians 6:11 reads, “Put on the whole \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_, that ye may be able to stand against the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_.”
- f) What verse begins, “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood...?”
- g) Ephesians 6:14 begins, “\_\_\_\_\_ therefore...”
- h) What verse references “the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God?”
- i) What person is referred to by Paul as being “a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord?”

1) Psalm 44 – Read & Answer Below

- b) Did Israel conquer the land of Canaan because of their strength and might?

- e) The psalmist says that God “...hast scattered us among the heathen” in what passage?
- f) Psalm 44:18 reads, “Our \_\_\_\_\_ is not turned back, neither have our steps \_\_\_\_\_ from Thy way.”
- g) What verse says that God “...knoweth the secrets of the heart?”
